

Spring in Carinthia is an “Easter secret”



In spring, locals and visitors alike will again feel increasingly drawn outdoors. For example, to the Benediktinermarkt, a market square in the centre of Klagenfurt am Wörthersee where the farmers of the area offer the first spring flowers, early vegetables, plants and pussy willows. Furthermore, here you will find everything that you need for a typical Carinthian Easter meal.

Easter Market

The traditional Easter Market with its colourfully decorated stands is a highlight in spring where you can get everything from arts and crafts to decorative Easter arrangements and cakes and pastries. Particularly popular is the famous Carinthian ‘Reindling’, a secret made of yeast dough and a must for the typical Easter meal.



On the clear cycle paths and idyllic running routes along the Sattnitz river or at the lake the first sport lovers can be seen again as it’s time for leisurely walking and running; and golfers can practise their first drives at the Klagenfurt-Seltenheim golf course.

Armorial Hall, Minimundus and Parish Church Tower are opening their doors again.

In spring, the white passenger boats of the Wörtherseeschiffahrt will set off again on a voyage of discovery. Nowhere else will you have better views of the beautiful villas in Wörthersee architectural style. In addition, the Wörtherseeschiffahrt also offers various themed boat trips.

Leisurely cruises aboard the small ‘Lendwurm’ passenger boat are offered twice a day on the 450 year old Lendkanal waterway from the old town to the lake. On the way to the eastern bay of the lake, you’ll have the opportunity to make a detour to Minimundus, the miniature world at Lake Wörthersee. Again from mid-April you can set out on a trip around the world and visit 140 models of the most beautiful buildings in the world that are presented here, true to the last detail.



In April, the large Armorial Hall in the Landhaus building will open its doors again. Apart from mural and ceiling frescoes, 665 coats of arms of the Carinthian Provincial Estates are shown. The baroque works of art were created by the painter, Ferdinand Fromiller. The Parish Church Tower will provide the best views of Klagenfurt again from March on.
